All Star tryout guidelines

- 1. All players wanting to play All stars need to tryout, if they can't be there the day of tryouts then they need to work out another day to tryout for the team.
- Player evaluations are based on fielding, catching, hitting, pitching and catching skills. For All stars players should be into positions for coaches to properly evaluate their skills. Rotate the players between outfield and infield positions to see players in all situations.
- 3. Evaluations need to be performed by Head coach for team, coaches from other teams and board members. Evaluation grades should be given for each player to assist with choosing players.
- 4. Players who play up during the season need to tryout for that division. If a player is eligible to play down and choose to do so, they have to tryout for that age group also. There are no guaranteed spots.
- 5. Coaches should be watching players during the season to help them with All star selection in case they are selected as a coach and to help selected coach with evaluation of players if needed.
- 6. All Star teams will have no more than 3 coaches per team. Head coach and 2 assistant coaches.
- 7. Coaches need to be from current season.
- 8. Board will meet with coaches to go over roster to assure best team is selected.
