DRAFT RULES

The night of the draft only the head coach and one assistant coach is allowed in the room for the draft. Once players scores are tallied, coaches will be given their evaluation sheets back to use for their notes during the draft. If there are any questions during the draft please be respectful to others in the room and go to the draft coordinator to help get your questions answered. Each draft will be assigned a draft coordinator by the MASA board for running the draft.

- Players evaluation scores will be tallied and an average created.
- Players' average score will be written on the players cards ranging from a 1 to 3 with 3 being the highest score a player can be given.
- Players cards will be placed on the table by their scores starting with all 3'a together, then all 2's together and then all 1's together.
- For the mix division girls 13 and older need to be separated out from the other players on the table and need to be split between the teams during the draft to make sure all teams have some of the older girls.
- Catchers and pitchers need to be separated out and will have their own area on the table so coaches can see all pitchers and catchers that are available.
- Teams that don't have a pitcher or catcher as their save get first pick at catchers and
 pitchers on the table. Once all teams have a catcher and pitcher drafted the remaining
 on the table are available to anyone.
- Each team gets 3 saves, coaches have to save their daughter and their assistant daughter, 3 saves can be anyone in the draft that hasn't been claimed by another team.
- If we have sisters playing in the same age group they have to be drafted together. If a coach saves a player with a sister they have to take both of them unless it's agreed upon by the board and coaches before the draft starts.
- If 2 coaches want the same player it will be granted to the coach that coaches them the season before or by seniority.
- The draft will be snake draft style starting with the team that has the lowest score from averaging the score of their 3 saves.
- Coach with lowest score picks first, second lowest picks second, the coach with the highest average from their saves will pick last.
- Coaches will be assigned a board member to help keep track of who they picked as we draft. They will record the picks and create the spreadsheet for that team, including team name, team uniform colors and coaches shirt sizes.
- Any player that isn't able to show up for evaluations will be put into the hat pick. The hat
 picks will be put out on the table after all players have been drafted. Hat picks will
 continue where the draft order stopped after the last player was drafted from the original
 draft.
- Once all players have been drafted, coaches have 5 minutes to make any trades they wish to try and make.

•	Teams that have less players than others after the draft will get a player added to their team from the waiting list. This will happen until all teams have the same amount of players.
